Closure under reverse 9/10/2019 Sofya Raskhodnikova; based on slides by Nick Hopper
 Theorem The reverse of a regular language is also regular
 Proof: Let L be a regular language and M be a DFA that recognizes it
 Construct an NFA M' recognizing L^R :
 • Define M' as M with the arrows reversed
 • Make the start state of M be the accept state in M'
